Truly God has been good throughout my life and as I rely on him forever, I believe He will enrich me with His unfailing love in the coming days too. It is with my whole heart I express my gratitude to Dr. Caroline Michael, for giving this opportunity to share my testimony through Chalk and Chai.

My life was on rocky roads with regards to health which I consider it as a testing time in my life, if not I wouldn't have got a chance to praise God now and always. I was diagnosed with kidney disease and was undergoing dialysis for 6 years which consumed the entire happiness of my marriage life, but nevertheless I thank God for my parents, my husband and my extended family who have been a backbone to me throughout my situation.

Balancing family life with work and treatment was really looking dense for me. My hope was given up on one situation when getting a kidney donor was tough as there was no proper match for many years and in this process the Lord taught me how to be patient and rely only on Him in every situation. My only hope was Jesus alone who gave His life for me. I strongly believed Him to touch me and heal me.

One fine day on 22nd February 2022, as we got a call from the hospital stating about the availability of a kidney, my entire family hoped for a better life for me but that happiness was shattered as the donor backed off which brought the thoughts of end of my life. I came back home from hospital with 3 thoughts hovering around my mind. Firstly, I wanted to take my own life the next day itself, and was waiting for my husband to leave to work. Secondly, I asked God that I desperately wanted a new life no matter what may come, if not the third was, to help me face this world which is shooting so many questions and letting me down as my weakness was exposed easily. But like any other human being with negativity playing an upper hand in such hard times, I stuck onto the first option strongly as I felt I was saturated with my painful life and in this process, I felt I was troubling my entire family. These thoughts were just circling my mind.

But my God is so powerful and He just proved time and again that He will never leave me nor forsake me even though I let go He didn't let go off me. It was the same day out of deep agony during dinner prayer time my husband and myself were in distress and as I was

running out of words due to anguish, I just prayed “God let your will be done in my life and whatever happens let it happen for your glory alone”, and as my husband and myself we said Amen, my husband's phone rang with hospital call stating that the donor who backed off came back saying that the family is ready to donate the kidney and I am supposed to enter the hospital the next day for a matching process. The next day by the grace of my God Jesus and His mercy the kidney matched and I underwent a kidney transplant on 25th February 2022, and till date I am a living witness along with my family for all that the Lord has done and still continuing to do through various means. I thank my friends who are close to my heart who have been watchful of me every time and prayed ardently for my good health and my family who have held me with great support and still continuing to do so.

Friends, as I write this, I affirm that in the name of Jesus no matter what you are going through, there is always a powerful name to call out who is besides you working in you always and that is JESUS, for with Him all things are possible. Am sure everyone who is reading this will one day share your life's testimony as the Lord has already started working in your life too. Stay blessed.

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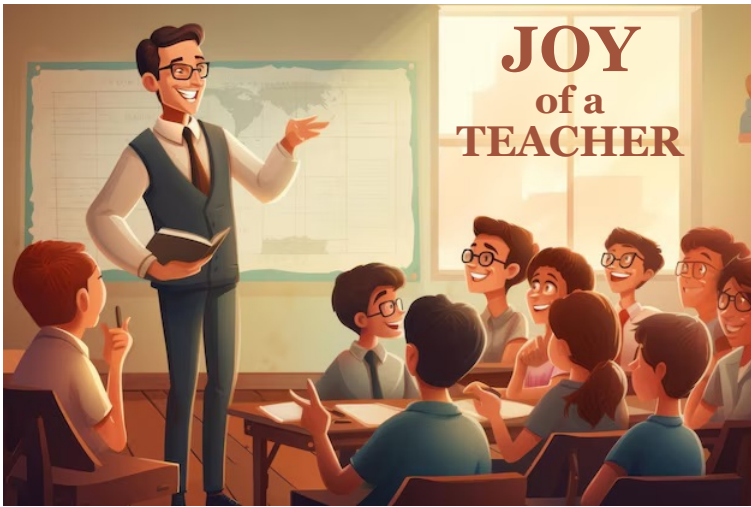
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During my college days, after receiving Christ Jesus as my personal saviour, I always wanted to work among youths. At the age of 23, I joined as Teacher in a Degree College. In the college we had one period of Devotion, where we had songs and preaching of the Word of God, every alternate day in the week. All students were welcome and many of them came and attended.

Now I am 35 years old and am working in another College. On many occasions, I met my students of both the colleges whom I didn't remember, but they remembered and greeted me and sometimes they would share about how they were and what they were doing. Is it not a moment of joy for a teacher when old students meet the teacher and give honour and a smile with happiness? Is it not a joyful moment when they meet us in the presence of many of their friends and acknowledge our good deeds because of which they are what they are today? Is it not a joyful moment when you meet people who once were naughty/stubborn/rebellious in their student life and used to stand outside the class regularly but are now respon-

sible men and women and good citizens of our nation! Is it not joyful when people who once were our students meet us, show respect addressing us as 'Sir' or 'Ma'am', and say, "I was your student and of such and such a batch and now I am doing this job!" Yes, teaching students and spending our precious time mentoring human lives is truly a joyful work.

A few days back, while evaluating the test papers, I was shocked and surprised by a note in a particular student's test paper. The student had written, "Sir, I am not able to concentrate on my studies, though I am trying to study for 2-3 hours. I am depressed and my parents and family are not understanding me. Sir, if you can help me, please call me." I wanted to help him when I saw it, but I thought that he was just pleading with me for marks. But I decided to enquire about the matter and so I called him to talk with him. He said that few days before the exam he was drunk along with his friends and was driving with his friends and met with a car accident in which his car collided with three other cars. His parents had to spend lakhs of

money to rescue him from the situation and to pay a fine in the police station. After that, I counselled him and also spoke with his parents and reconciled them. Is it not joyful to bring families together and walk an extra mile with students who are not good and not interested in their studies and who don't have a good relationship with their families? Jesus said in John 15:11-12, *"These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you."*

Sometimes we may look at ourselves as insignificant people, but let's look at ourselves from God's perspective and also from students' viewpoint.

- We teachers are Change Agents.
- We teachers are the light for students who don't know the various paths of life and are groping in the darkness of life's challenges.

In Matthew 5:16 we read, *"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."*

We teachers are important and the most respectable people, for we are mentoring young lives and are God's fellow workers (1 Corinthians 3:9) in His task of transforming lives.

I know a few teachers who are already in the teaching profession just for the sake of earning a salary every month, even though the profession is not a high-paying job. Few teachers are in the teaching profession just to keep themselves engaged in some work during the day and they don't have any

inspiration to influence, to make a lasting impact and to build the students' lives. But very few have entered the teaching profession with a zeal and goal to influence young lives.

Academically, every teacher is well qualified in his/her subject and he/she performs his/her duty very effectively. How many of us go to our workplace (schools/colleges) every day with the zeal or enthusiasm that every single day we should interact with students and influence them with our right lifestyle and right behaviour which can mould the behaviour, thought pattern, actions and language of students. *Jesus is the supreme teacher and people called him 'Master' or 'Guru', not just because of his teaching but also because of his life in action which coincided with what He said.* Teaching is definitely tough, but if it is done out of love and the realisation that God wants us to be like Him, it becomes joyful; after which taking extra classes, receiving less salary and extra workload during holidays will not be painful and burdensome. We are teachers and even today our lives and our teaching profession changes the life of individuals who will become families and positively influence our society and even nations.

Paul writes in Colossians 3:17, *"Whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."*

The Joy of Being a Teacher



The Quality Guru Williams Edwards Demings has rightly said
“People are entitled to Joy in Work”.

These lines evoked a sudden light-heartedness in my heart, when I read them last week because the word 'work' naturally generates in us feelings of burden, heaviness and stress. Today work can be compared to a great roller coaster phenomena people are engaged in till they reach fifty-eight (or whenever they superannuate), only to realize that in all the years that have gone by them, they have missed the single most vital ingredient God intended them to have - that is 'Joy'

The Hebrew language uses a variety of words for joy and happiness. One is '**Simcha**' which means gladness. This is used when people are filled with gladness in God's presence. It appears four hundred times in the Bible and means an external expression of Joy. For me being in the presence of God is vital to my existence and is also important to me as a professional teacher. This is because,

stepping into a classroom with the joy of the Lord, helps me to bring hundreds of students a sense of peace and assurance. Today's students' carry unspoken and unseen burdens of panic, depression, peer pressure, challenges in relationships and the constant barrage of social media stress, leaving them robbed of the happiness of simple pleasures. I make it a point to step into the classroom with a smile and so put them at ease. Invariably the joy in my heart will surface through a twinkle in the eyes and a warm smile. Try it beloved teachers! We definitely are not perfect, but we can change the atmosphere of our class with our smile and happy words.

Another word for joy is **Orah** which means light and happy. This joy is expressed in a jubilant skip and a jump of happy feet. My mother started a School in the Dharavi area in Mumbai. Dharavi is Asia's largest slums. Today my husband

and I continue her legacy by running the School. It is such a joy to see the little students expressing this lightheartedness. Adulthood brings its pressures and seriousness, but for me, just looking at these children makes me want to skip and dance. All our preprimary teachers, working at the School know that dancing, skipping, jumping and singing are a part of the curriculum and are actual periods in the timetable. How lovely and lively life would be if we include these subjects in our life's time table!

The word for Singing shouts of joy in Hebrew is **Rinnah**, in the Greek language the word 'giyl' or 'guwl' is used which means 'to spin around' these words are expressed in Philippians 4:4 'rejoice in the lord', which is one of the shortest verses in the Bible. (In Greek it is shorter than the famous 'Jesus wept'). Even as I pen these lines I can hear the vibrant joyful chatter of children. Moreover, as a Warden of my College Girls Hostel for the past twenty-two years I have experienced the joyful laughter of light hearted teenagers that engulfs me almost daily, even sometimes at twelve a.m. on a birthday! I don't think many workplaces are as full of joy and laughter as a teacher's is! This is what makes me 'spin around too'.

For me teaching is a vocation of my choice and I thank God for guiding me with this decision. God called me to teach His word when I was thirteen years old at Sunday School in Church and I loved it from day one. Later I completed my twelfth standard in the science field and attempted to join the medical career. However I changed my mind and took up the renowned three year course in Hotel Management from Dadar Catering College, Bombay. I vividly remember

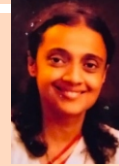
that day, having completed three years of Hotel Management, I sat one day on the sofa thinking 'I had a Diploma in Hotel Management, Catering Technology and Applied Nutrition from the best College in the Country, I also had a good job waiting for me at the Airport Leela Hotel. My parents joined me on the sofa and I looked into the eyes of my mother who was a teacher all her life and was the Principal for twenty years in one of the best Schools in South Bombay, the Queen Mary School. I also remembered, my grandmother was a French and Maths teacher, my grandfather was an English teacher, my dad's mother was a headmistress of a municipality school and my paternal grand dad was a music and a Bible teacher. My mum asked me what I was thinking about and if I really wanted to take up the profession of a Hotelier. I was not convinced at becoming a Hotelier and I told her that I didn't want to work in a place where I would not be able to enjoy my work. Deep inside I wanted to work with students, youngsters and children around me. I wanted to work in a College or a School. I wanted to look into those innocent eyes, and hear the laughter of youth and sing songs with them and tell them all the beautiful things about God, His creation and life. My dad (one of the kindest men in the world) asked me what I needed to do to become all this!! My mum had the list ready- BA, MA, B. Ed. She was so happy and excited. One more teacher added to the great gang of teachers! The years seemed to fly past as I stood in the University of Mumbai's Convocation Darbar Hall receiving my Degree in Education from the Vice Chancellor of the University. How excited and honored I felt. God wanted me to be a teacher and I became one. This is the deep seated joy that fills my heart and so I conclude with

yet one more word for Joy in Hebrew and that is **Osher**, which means deep and lasting happiness.

The joy of being a teacher has stayed with me for more than four decades and will be with me till I breathe my last. Seeing students grow into mature and responsible men and women of God, taking their place in this world, brings me joy. Seeing the weak and vulnerable filled with God's Spirit as they respond to His love, thrills me to my bones. Seeing the depraved and addicted change into worthy Human Beings increases my faith in the 'all transforming' power of Christ. All this brings Joy, Joy in heaven and joy in the classrooms. We as teachers are human engineers! Engineers!! Yes. How easy it is to cut, copy and paste on a life-less computer desktop, but only God's Spirit and love can delete and destroy

the works of the Devil in the minds and hearts of our precious students. Being aware of this important commission God has given me, fills me with gratitude and joy that I chose the teaching vocation. Yes, beloved teachers you and I are Human Engineers 'touching heaven and changing Earth' and in turn getting filled with God's joy downloaded straight from His presence.

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Greetings to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We live in a day and age where Science and knowledge are held supreme and God and the Word of God are often neglected or considered outdated among academicians. In this article, we shall explore the size of the DNA molecule and comprehend the wonderful work of God in creating us.

Size of the DNA

The Bible says in Psalm 139 verses 13-15 that God's hand is involved in the creation of every human being when they are in their mother's womb.

For you formed my inward parts; You knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in the secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth.

Notice the words knitted and intricately woven. What was God talking about? God talked about knitting the base pairs in the DNA strands and intricately weaving the DNA inside the chromosomes around the histones. DNA molecules are so long that they can't fit into cells without the right packaging. DNA is coiled tightly to fit inside cells to form structures called chromosomes. Each chromosome contains a single DNA molecule.

“The haploid human genome contains approximately 3 billion base pairs of DNA packaged into 23 chromosomes. Of course, most cells in the body (except for female ova and male sperm) are diploid, with 23 pairs of chromosomes. That makes a total of 6 billion base pairs of DNA per cell. Because each base pair is around 0.34 nanometers long (a nanometer is one-billionth of a meter), each diploid cell therefore contains about 2 meters of DNA $[(0.34 \times 10^{-9}) \times (6 \times 10^9)]$.”

Calculation:

No of base pairs of DNA in a diploid cell = 6 Billion = 6×10^9 base pairs

Length of each base pair of the DNA = 0.34 nm = 0.34×10^{-9} m

Total length of DNA in each diploid cell = (No of base pairs) x Length of base pairs) = $(6 \times 10^9) \times (0.34 \times 10^{-9} \text{ m}) = 2 \text{ meters}$

The Size of the human cell depends on its function for example Red blood cells: are 7-8 micrometers in diameter, and 100 micrometers in volume. Fat cell: 100 micrometers in diameter. Muscle fiber cell: 100 micrometers in diameter. Megakaryocytes: 100 micrometers in diameter. Mature female egg cells are about 120 micrometers in diameter. Nerve cells or neurons reach lengths of over a meter but with a diameter of only about 10 micrometers.

Evolutionists can never explain how a 2-meter-long DNA molecule got itself coiled inside a tiny human cell whose average size is about 100 micrometers in diameter. Each human cell contains approximately 2 meters of DNA if stretched end-to-end; yet the nucleus of a human cell, which contains the DNA, is only about 6 μm in diameter. This is geometrically equivalent to packing 40 km (24 miles) of extremely fine thread into a tennis ball! And evolutionists say it happened by itself!

The Bible says in Isaiah 44:24: ***“Thus says the Lord your redeemer And He who formed you from the womb. I am the Lord who makes all things who stretches out the heavens all alone, who spreads abroad the earth by Myself.”***

I used to wonder why God is quoting the work He does when we are in the womb along with the gigantic things like stretching the heavens. Does this have any connection? How long can a human being be stretched? Well if we try to stretch all the DNA molecules inside a human body and place it end to end. The entire size or the total length of the DNA molecules is mind boggling. We can calculate the total length or distance the DNA molecules can be stretched.

Calculation:

The number of diploid cells in the human body = 50 trillion = 50×10^{12} cells
Total Length of DNA in the human body = (Length of DNA in each cell) x (No of cells) = **(2 meters) x (50 trillion) = 100 trillion meters = 100×10^{12} meters**
Distance between the Earth and the Sun = 150 billion meters = 150×10^9 meters
No of times the DNA can go to the sun =
Total Length of DNA in the human body/ Distance between the Earth and the Sun
 $(100 \times 10^{12} / 150 \times 10^9) = 666 \text{ times.}$
No of trips our DNA can make from the earth to the sun and back = **333 times.**

The works of God are wonderful too marvelous for comprehension. The Scientific truths hidden in the Word of God must be explored, studied, and understood to strengthen our Faith in God and have a deeper understanding of His Holy Word. Hope to come up with more Scientific truths from the Bible.
